Hoover Citizens can turn in their unused or expired prescription/non-prescription medications to the Hoover Police Department (with no questions asked) in the following ways:

- The annual Hoover [Hazardous Waste Day](#)

Check the City of Hoover's website for dates and times.

- The semi-annual "Prescription Drug Take-Back Day"

One day in October and one day in April (both TBD). The National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day aims to provide a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs, while also educating the general public about the potential for abuse of medications.
